Baxter State Park Camping Summer Rates Effective January 1, 2003 — Rates subject to change:

Cabins: \$22.00 per adult per night; \$13.00 per child 7-16 years old; 6 years and under are free.

Minimum Cabin Fees: \$65.00 for a 6 or 4 person cabin; \$52.00 for a 3 person cabin; \$39.00 for a 2 person cabin.

Tentsites and Leanto sites: \$8.00 per person per night for anyone 7 years or older.

Minimum Tentsite and Leanto Fees: \$16.00 per night.

Bunkhouse: \$9.00 per person per night for anyone 7 years or older.

Group Areas: Avalanche and Foster Field are \$8.00 per person per night for up to 12 people; for 13 or more people it is \$4.00 per person per night. Trout Brook and Nesowadnehunk is \$4.00 per person per night. Group area minimum is 6 people.

Family Rates: Trout Brook Farm and Nesowadnehunk have family rates of \$16.00 per tentsite, not over capacity.

BAXTER STATE PARK FACILITIES

DRIVE TO CAMPGROUNDS:

ROARING BROOK CAMPGROUND: 11 lean-tos/10 tentsites/8-person bunkhouse. Hiking, fishing. Skiing (winter only). 26 mi NW of Millinocket. Outhouses; no showers. Open 5/15 - 10/15.

ABOL CAMPGROUND: 12 lean-tos/9 tentsites. 24 mi NW of Millinocket. Hiking, fishing. Skiing (winter only). Outhouses; no showers. Open 5/15 - 10/15.

KATAHDIN STREAM CAMPGROUND: 12 lean-tos/9 tentsites. Hiking, fishing. Skiing (winter only). 26 mi NW of Millinocket. Outhouses; no showers. Open 5/15 - 10/15.

DAICEY POND CAMPGROUND: 11 cabins (wilderness type). Cabins are equipped with beds, a stove for heat and gas lights. (All bedding and cooking utensils MUST be provided by the camper.) Outdoor fireplaces for cooking and picnic tables are provided. Hiking, canoeing, fishing. Skiing (winter only). Fees for canoes. 30 mi NW of Millinocket. Outhouses; no showers. Open 5/15 - 10/15.

KIDNEY POND CAMPGROUND: 12 cabins (wilderness type). Cabins are equipped with beds, a stove for heat and gas lights. (All bedding and cooking utensils MUST be provided by the camper.) Outdoor fireplaces for cooking and picnic tables are provided (communal fireplaces are provided for some cabins). Hiking, canoeing, fishing. Skiing (winter only). Fees for canoes. 30 mi NW of Millinocket. Outhouses; no showers. Open Memorial Weekend to 10/15.

NESOWADNEHUNK FIELD CAMPGROUND: 11 lean-tos/12 tentsites. Hiking, fishing. Skiing (winter only). 35 mi NW of Millinocket. Outhouses; no showers. Open mid-June to mid-September.

SOUTH BRANCH POND CAMPGROUND: 12 lean-tos/21 tentsites/8-person bunkhouse. Hiking, canoeing, fishing. Skiing (winter only). Fees for canoes. Outhouses; no showers. 34 mi W of Patten. Open 5/15 - 10/15.

TROUT BROOK FARM CAMPGROUND: 14 tentsites/1 lean-to. Hiking, fishing. Skiing (winter only). Outhouses; no showers. 26-1/2 mi W of Patten. Open Memorial Weekend to Labor Day.

BACKPACKING ONLY:

CHIMNEY POND CAMPGROUND: 9 lean-tos/10-person bunkhouse. Backpack 3.3 mi from Roaring Brook. Outhouses; no showers. Open 6/1 - 10/15. Rock and ice climbing per Ranger approval. Established cut-off time for leaving to hike into Chimney Pond is **5:00 p.m.***

RUSSELL POND CAMPGROUND: 5 lean-tos/3 tentsites/8-person bunkhouse. Outhouses. Hiking, fishing. Skiing (winter only). Fees for canoes. Backpack 7 mi from Roaring Brook, or 9 mi from South Branch Pond. Open 5/15 - 10/15. Established cutoff time for leaving to hike to Russell is **2:00 p.m.*** There are no bridges over Wassataquoik Stream - rock hopping and wading necessary.

OUTLYING SITES: Various lean-tos and tentsites. An additional handout is available for outlying sites in the Park.

*As daylight hours shorten in the fall, posted cut-off time is earlier. Please verify these cut-off times with the reservation office and make your plans accordingly.

VEHICLE SIZE: No vehicle which exceeds an overall dimension of 9' high, 7' wide, or 22' long for single units (44' for combined units) will be allowed to enter the Park.

NO PETS.

WATER: All water sources will be untreated, open sources. Please plan to treat your water by boiling, using chemicals or a filter OR bring sufficient water from home.

FACILITY CAPACITY: When considering capacity of all facilities, each child is counted as one individual regardless of age. Cabin capacity is restricted. Before adding people to your party, consult with Reservation Clerk, Baxter State Park, 64 Balsam Drive, Millinocket, Maine 04462, Tel: (207) 723-5140 to be sure your site will hold additional people.

THERE ARE NO ELECTRIC, WATER OR SEWER HOOK-UPS.
